## CONSEQUENCES OF SIN

1. The **death** of his son born by Bathsheba (2 Sam 12:14-19)
  2. One of David's sons, Amnon, **rapes** one of David's Daughters, Tamar (13:1-16)
  3. **Hatred** grew leading to death of David's son, Amnon, at the hands of another son, Absalom (13:20-29)
  4. Absalom **conspires** against his father, David, for the throne of Israel (13:34-15:16)
  5. David's son Absalom is **executed** ((18:9-15, 32-33)
- Even when we are forgiven our sin, sin still has consequences

#### The Journeying Psalm – Psalm 121

To cope with the journey God brought David along, David:

1. Kept looking to the **greatness** of God (Psalm 121:1-2)
  2. Kept **placing** His trust in the Lord (vs.2-8)
- David modelled the need to move ahead, not get stuck (vs.3, 6, 8) under the consequences of our sin
