Includes: Hatred, lust, anger, abuse, mistrust, death

We reap what we sow (Galatians 6:7-8) – *"Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap."*

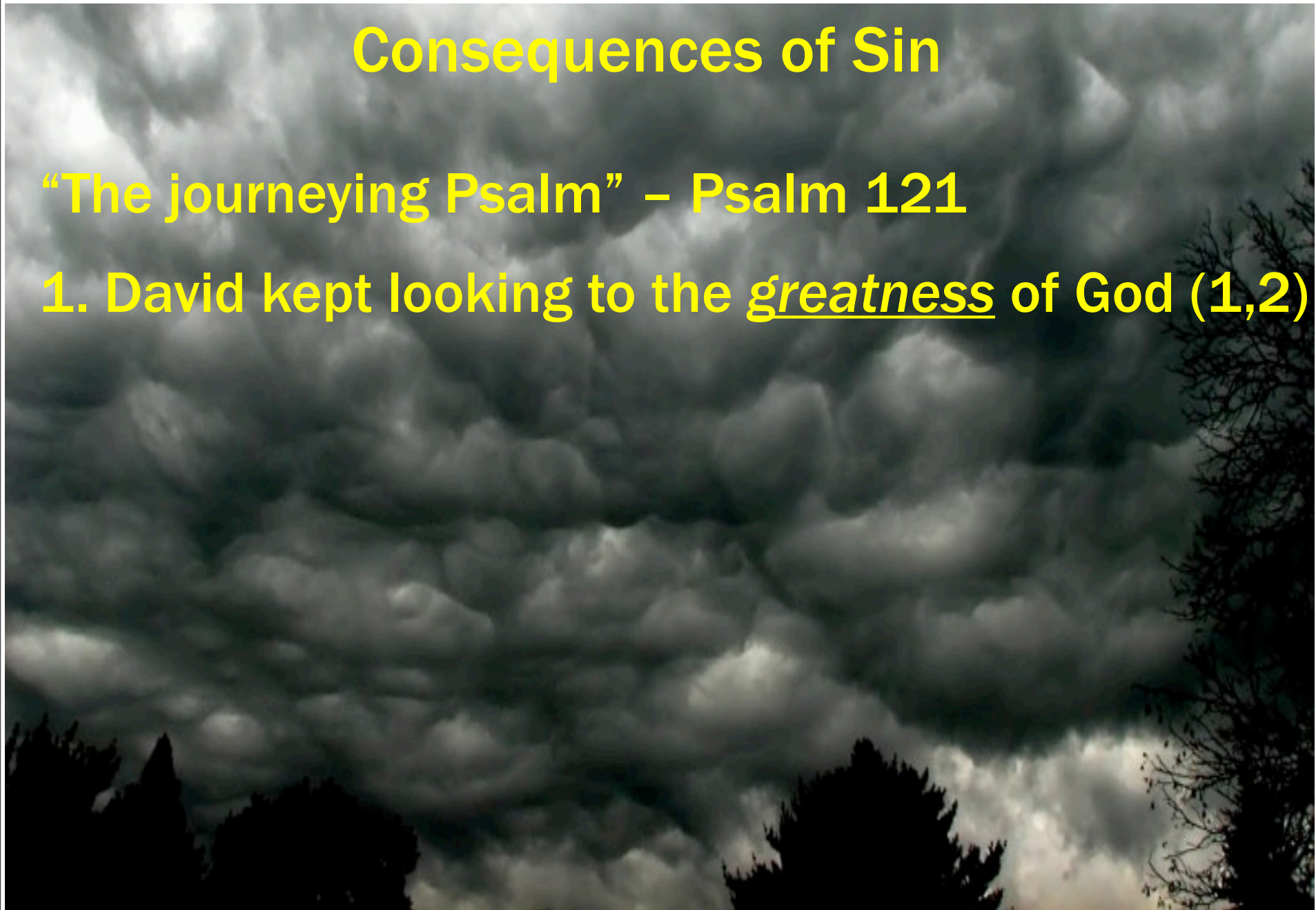
