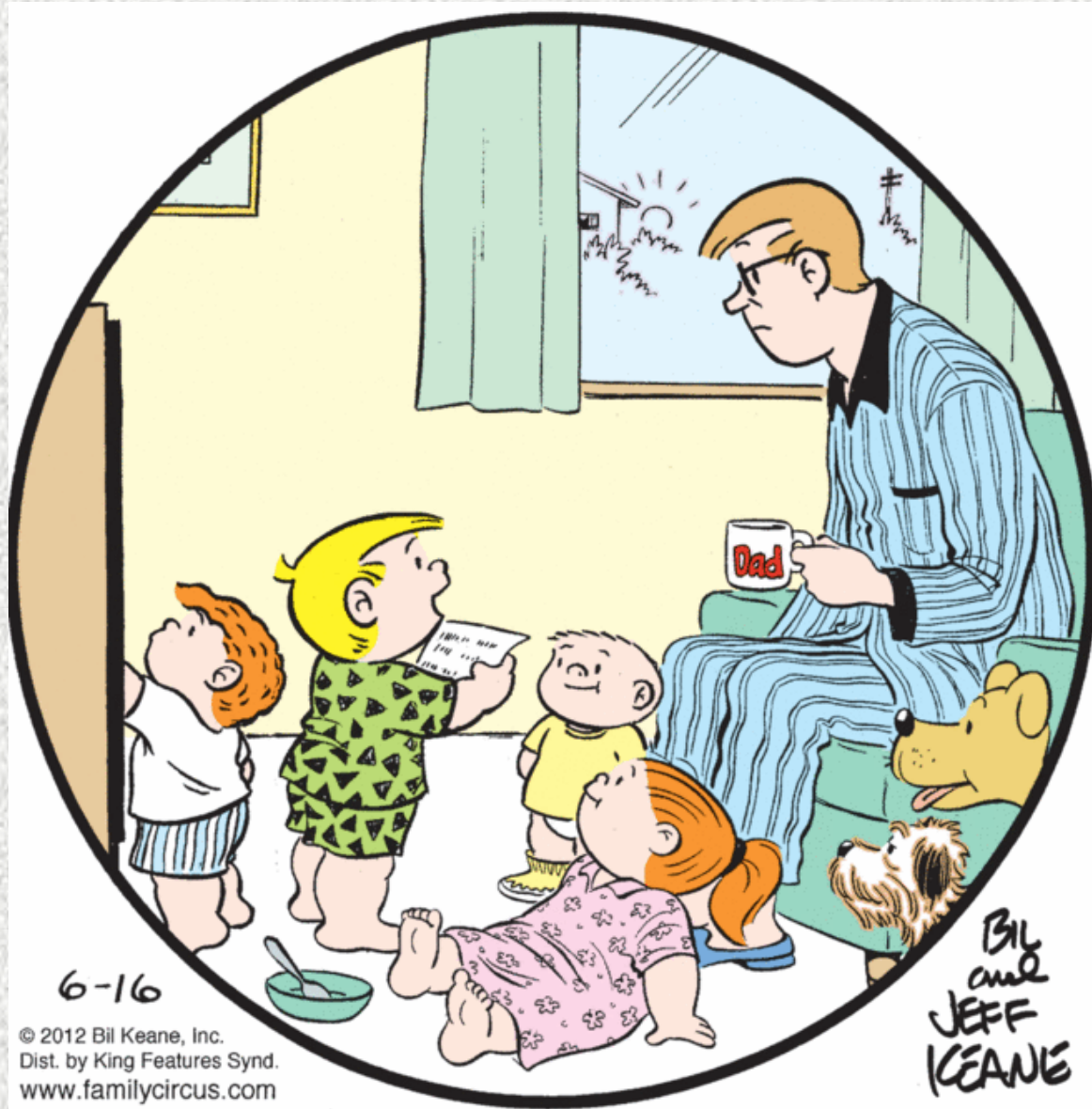
Principles of Godly Care
