Can be connected

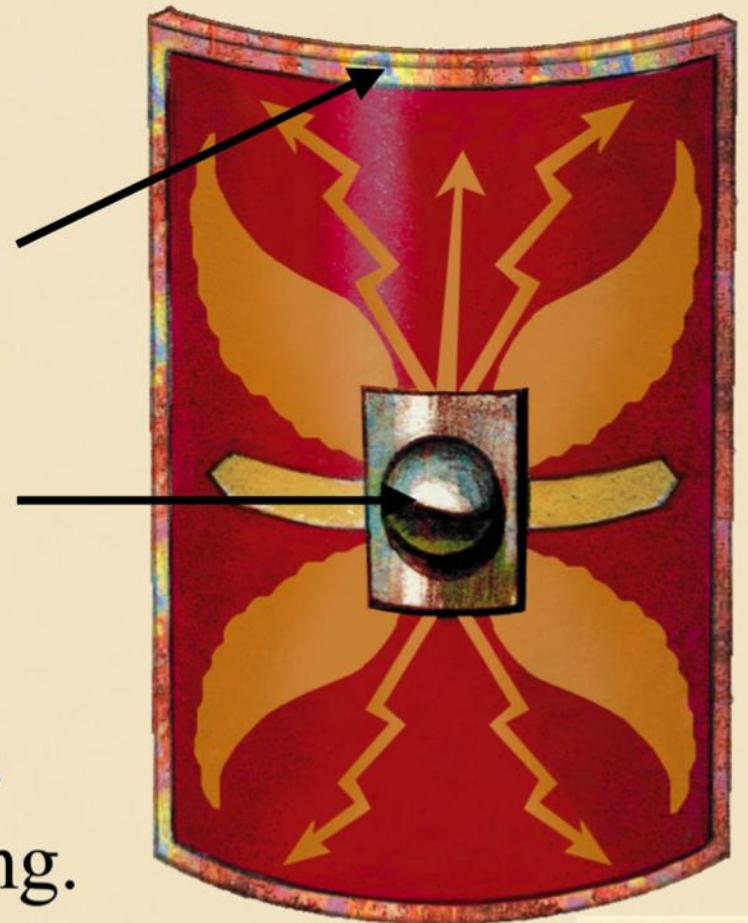
**Protects the rest of the

Shield of Faith

Description of Armor

- ✦ Iron rims were then fitted along the top and bottom edges, and an iron circle was attached to the center of the shield.
- ✦ The colors of the soldier's military unit were sometimes painted on the leather covering.
